Memory Work Helps

“Repetitio est mater studiorum,”

says the Latin proverb. *“Repetition is the mother of learning.”* Consistently repeating something, from a Bible verse to a new habit, will engrain it into our mind and heart. Think of how many things we do during a day because we are in the habit of doing it (because we’ve repeated the same action over and over again) - brushing our teeth or saying meal time prayers.

Repetition is a key to learning and committing God’s Word to your head and having it affect your heart. Here are some suggestions:

- Read through your flashcards (new ones and review ones) once every morning and once every evening. Don’t skip the ones you already know—repeat, repeat, repeat!
- Read your each of your new flashcards three times out loud. Read or recite out loud your review flashcards (any flashcards you’ve already memorized) once.
- Parents—read the memory work you are working on (or a portion of it) to your child and have them repeat it back to you several times.
