

Psalm 141 is a traditional evening psalm. Incense symbolizes the prayers of the faithful ascending from earth to heaven. A more ancient Christian understanding is that clouds of incense represent cleansing and purification (Numbers 16:46-47) and the covering over of sin with the sweetness of Christ's self-sacrifice.



## Let us pray:


Let our prayers be acceptable in your sight. Come and help us in time of need that we may sing your praise in holy joy now and forever, through Jesus Christ, our Lord.
