



## SERVICE NOTES FOR THIS SUNDAY



Christ is risen! He is risen indeed! Sinners should fear God.
Sinners ought to die for their wickedness. The grave should
be the place of ultimate defeat for mankind. Yet on this day,
Jesus died, but three days later he rose in glory. As a result,
fear is gone, mankind is redeemed, and Christ calls us his own
brothers. Jesus came from death to life, and through baptism
he brings us with him.

## **BEFORE WORSHIP**

As you prepare to worship your Lord today, spend a few quiet moments in prayer before the service. Review the lessons, the service notes, and pray this prayer:

Almighty God, by the glorious resurrection of your Son Jesus Christ you conquered death and opened the gate to eternal life. Grant that we, who have been raised with him through baptism, may walk in the newness of life and ever rejoice in the hope of sharing his glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever. Amen.

## **GREETING**

(L)eader: The grace of our Lord (†) Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.

(C)ongregation: And also with you.

## **CONFESSION OF SINS**

- L: We have come into the presence of God, who created us to love and serve him as his dear children. But we have disobeyed him and deserve only his wrath and punishment.

  Therefore, let us confess our sins to him and plead for his mercy.
- C: Merciful Father in heaven, I am altogether sinful from birth. In countless ways I have sinned against you and do not deserve to be called your child. But trusting in Jesus, my Savior, I pray: Have mercy on me according to your unfailing love. Cleanse me from my sin, and take away my guilt.
- L: God, our heavenly Father, has forgiven all your sins. By the perfect life and innocent death of our Lord Jesus Christ, he has removed your guilt forever. You are his own dear child. May God give you strength to live according to his will.

Worthy is Christ, the Lamb who was slain, whose blood sets us free to be people of God. **Refrain** 

Power, riches, wisdom, and strength, and honor, blessing, and glory are his. **Refrain**Sing with all the people of God, and join in the hymn of all creation: **Refrain**Blessing, honor, glory, and might be to God and the Lamb forever. Amen. **Refrain**For the Lamb who was slain has begun his reign. Alleluia! **Refrain** 

The use of the keys (the power to forgive sins) is that special power and right which Christ gave to his church on earth: to forgive the sins of penitent sinners (See John 20:21-23).

This greeting has deep roots in Christian worship.


- L: The Lord be with you.

## THE WORD

### FIRST LESSON

JONAH 2:2-9 (PG. 1437)

## <sup>2</sup> He said:

"In my distress I called to the LORD, and he answered me. From the depths of the grave I called for help, and you listened to my cry.

- You hurled me into the deep, into the very heart of the seas, and the currents swirled about me; all your waves and breakers swept over me.
- <sup>4</sup> I said, 'I have been banished from your sight; yet I will look again toward your holy temple.'
- The engulfing waters threatened me, the deep surrounded me; seaweed was wrapped around my head.
- To the roots of the mountains I sank down; the earth beneath barred me in forever. But you brought my life up from the pit, O LORD my God.
- When my life was ebbing away, I remembered you, LORD, and my prayer rose to you, to your holy temple.
- 8 "Those who cling to worthless idols forfeit the grace that could be theirs.

Salvation comes from the LORD."

<sup>9</sup> But I, with a song of thanksgiving, will sacrifice to you. What I have vowed I will make good.

Leader: Refrain.

Congregation: Refrain.

The congregation joins in singing the refrain after each of the verses.

Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his mercy endures forever; Let the house of Israel say: "His mercy endures forever." **Refrain.** 

The hand of the Lord has struck with pow'r, his right hand is exalted, I shall not die, but live anew, declaring the works of the Lord. **Refrain.** 

The stone which the builders rejected has become the cornerstone,
The Lord of love and mercy has brought wonder to our eyes! **Refrain.** 

### SECOND LESSON

COLOSSIANS 3:1-4 (PG. 1834)

Through baptism, God kills our sinful nature and raises a new man to life within us.

**3** Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. <sup>2</sup> Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. <sup>3</sup> For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. <sup>4</sup> When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

<sup>2</sup> There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. 3 His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. <sup>4</sup> The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men.

<sup>5</sup> The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. <sup>6</sup> He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. <sup>7</sup> Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.' Now I have told you."

 $^8$  So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples. <sup>9</sup> Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings," he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him. <sup>10</sup> Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me."





MATTHEW 28:1-10


## APOSTLES CREED

And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.



L: Brothers and sisters, go in peace. Live in harmony with one another. Serve the Lord with gladness.


