

RISEN TO FREE US!

TEXT: MATTHEW 28:5-10

⁵ The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. ⁶ He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. ⁷ Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.' Now I have told you."

⁸ So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples. ⁹ Suddenly Jesus met them. "Greetings," he said. They came to him, clasped his feet and worshiped him. ¹⁰ Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid. Go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee; there they will see me."

At Our Savior Lutheran, we use the ancient Christian practice of the Easter Greetings. Throughout the 50 days of Easter, whenever the pastor says, "Christ is risen!" the people respond, "He is Risen Indeed!"
